How to clean and protect

Dirty lenses can cause eyestrain due to forced focusing. Lens cleaning is a fundamental operation for vision and glasses maintenance that should be carried out daily. If done in a wrong way, approximately or with improvised tools it can cause scratches and damages to the lenses and to the treatments.

Yes



It is necessary to **put the glasses under cold water*** before each cleaning activity, in order to remove dust. Next **dry the lens** with a soft microfiber cloth



Clean the lens with a **mild detergent** or any over the counter lens/sunglass cleaner



Use a **soft and clean** microfiber cloth to dry the lens



Always store the glasses and the mask in their **protective case**

No



Never use warm water to clean the glasses as it could damage the treatments on the lens (anti-fog and anti-reflection treatment,...)



Do not clean with solvents, detergents and alcohol based cleaning products



Never use clothes, fingers and handkerchiefs to clean the lenses



Never put the glasses face down

* In case the substance present on the lens is known to react with water, we recommend removing it according to the precautions stated by the producer into his safety data sheet, avoiding contact with water.
